5 Directing the Legislative Council to
6 proceed with the revision of the
7 Administrative Code as set out in the
8 Legislative Council study of December
9 1966.

10 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 WHEREAS the Alaska Administrative Code is a growing body of administra-
12 tive law containing the regulations of executive agencies which implement
13 the laws passed by the Legislature; and

14 WHEREAS there has been increasing concern regarding the content, form
15 and availability for use of the Alaska Administrative Code as a vital body
16 of law; and

17 WHEREAS this increasing concern led to the Legislature directing the
18 Legislative Council to revise the regulations contained in the Alaska Ad-
19 ministrative Code into a more concise, meaningful and uniform body of law;
20 and

21 WHEREAS the Legislative Council completed, in December of 1966, a re-
22 view of the effectiveness and suitability of the Alaska Administrative Code;

23 BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council is directed to proceed with
24 the revision of the Alaska Administrative Code as set out in the Legislative
25 Council study of December 1966 "The Alaska Administrative Code."
