8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS the Captain Cook Jaycees have initiated this year a public

11 which consists of providing a means whereby private citizens may express  
12 their views on matters pending before the legislature; and

13 WHEREAS as a part of this project the Captain Cook Jaycees have al-

15 WHEREAS they have compiled a compendium of testimony received from  
16 the public and have made recommendations regarding certain pending legis-  
17 lative matters; and

19 lators from the Anchorage area and to the Governor by Richard W. McComb,  
20 President; Carl Brady, Jr., Project Chairman; and Ed Harter, all of the  
21 Captain Cook Jaycees; and

22 WHEREAS projects of this nature are of inestimable value to individual  
23 legislators and serve as a media for private individuals to express their  
24 views to the legislature;

25 BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of the State of Alaska commends  
26 the Captain Cook Jaycees for this valuable public service; and be it

27 FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislature of the State of Alaska expresses  
28 its fervent wish that projects of this nature be an annual undertaking by  
29 not only the Captain Cook Jaycees, but by Jaycees in all communities
