5 Commending the Alaska Association of
6 Insurance Agents for their contri-
7 butions to Fire and Highway Safety
8 Programs.

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 WHEREAS the Alaska Association of Insurance Agents has, year after
11 year, contributed to Alaska State Offices and state-wide organizations for
12 the continuation of Fire and Highway Programs for the safety of the public;
13 and

14 WHEREAS contributions to these programs constitutes a great service to
15 the people of the state because they are used for the purchase of safety
16 equipment for the Alaska Department of Public Safety, safety posters and
17 law books for the Department of Labor, safety films for the Alaska State
18 Film Library; financing instructors in fire safety programs of the Alaska
19 State Fire Marshal and the Alaska State Firemen's Association; financing
20 the Alaska Traffic Court Conference and the Alaska Jaycees Teen Driver Road
21 E-O; purchasing instructor driver kits for the Department of Public Safety;
22 contributing to the Alaska exhibits during the Worlds Fair; providing
23 50,000 drive safely auto bumper stickers, displaying the Alaska Centennial
24 insignia, and numerous other safety programs all designed for the best
25 interests and protection to all Alaskans; and

26 WHEREAS these projects are of inestimable value to the Alaska public
27 because they serve as a means to save lives and property;

28 BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature commends the Alaska Association of
29 Insurance Agents for its assistance in furthering fire and highway safety

1 program throughout the state and expresses its desire that the Association
2 will continue to support these programs in the future.
