5 Relating to a pilot program for  
6 teaching Alaska's youth the value  
7 of basic cleanliness and respect for  
8 its own and other people's property.

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 WHEREAS the youth of Alaska is our greatest natural resource; and

11 WHEREAS the needless scourge of litter, defacing of buildings, vandal-  
12 ising and the disrespect for each other's property does exist in our state  
13 discouraging Alaska's economic development and tourism and marring Alaska's  
14 great scenic beauty; and

15 WHEREAS great potential exists in Alaska's youth which has boundless  
16 energy and enthusiasm for whatever it does;

17 BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is respectfully requested to urge the  
18 Alaska Centennial Cleanup Program "Operation Big Sweep" to work with all  
19 pertinent state and federal agencies for setting up a pilot program in Alaska  
20 for teaching children and young adults the value of basic cleanliness in a  
21 community and respect for their own property as well as for property of  
22 others; and be it

23 FURTHER RESOLVED that all aspects of this program be reported back to  
24 the Legislature in January, 1968.
