8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS in the face of great adversity, the Salvation Army rendered
10 vital services to the people of the state following the flood of August 14,
11 1967; and

12 WHEREAS these valiant and tireless men and women were among the first
13 to rush into the stricken areas to minister to those in need and to care
14 for the disaster stricken; and

15 WHEREAS the devotion and skill, effort, and resources of the Salvation
16 Army organization and staff in furnishing badly needed food supplies and
17 clothing to the flood victims are in the highest traditions of their pro-
18 fession and calling and command the appreciation of all the people of the
19 State of Alaska;

20 BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of the State of Alaska extends, on
21 behalf of the people of Alaska, the gratitude and commendation of the state
22 to the Salvation Army for its past assistance and continuing service to the
23 people of the state.
