3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 FIFTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Relating to an in-depth study of state
6 rural schools.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS the progress and well-being of this state is dependent on a
9 well educated populace; and

10 WHEREAS, because of the immense size of the State of Alaska and the
11 sparse population of many areas, getting education to the people remains a
12 problem but one which has been obviated to a great extent by the state rural
13 schools; and

14 WHEREAS the continual upgrading of state rural schools is an important
15 facet of the whole Alaska educational program; and

16 WHEREAS in order to have the best possible rural educational program it
17 is necessary to have modern and well-equipped school facilities and to
18 facilitate this objective a careful study is required with a view toward
19 repair, remodeling, and expansion of school plants, teachers' quarters,
20 multi-purpose rooms, kitchens for hot lunch programs, and other integral
21 parts of the schools;

22 BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is respectfully requested to direct
23 the Department of Education to conduct an in-depth study of the improvements
24 required by the rural schools and report to the Sixth Legislature, First
25 Session on the necessary repairs, remodeling and expansion of the physical
26 plants of the state rural schools.
