Relating to the extension of the

Elliott-Manley Hot Springs Highway.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the Elliott-Manley Hot Springs Highway ends only 13 miles from

the Yukon River at Rampart; and

WHEREAS the Department of Highways has surveyed this 13-mile stretch

years ago; and

WHEREAS even though a complete survey has been made, the highway, to

date, has not been extended; and

WHEREAS if the highway were extended to the Yukon River at Rampart it

15

would benefit not only the people living in Rampart and Manley Hot Springs,

16

but would open up the area for all Alaskans and also to our many tourists;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is respectfully requested to direct

18

the Department of Highways to extend the existing Elliott-Manley Hot Springs

19

Highway for an additional 13 miles to the Yukon River at Rampart at the

earliest possible time.
