BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS Kodiak Island and the mainland areas of the state have a

growing agricultural industry; and

WHEREAS the state should do everything in its power to aid this growing

industry; and

WHEREAS a simple and economically sound method to aid the agricultural

13

industry in these areas would be to lower the ferry rates for agricultural

14

products;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is respectfully requested to direct

16

the Division of Marine Transportation, consistent with the fact discovered

17

through a study of the situation, to reduce as far as is feasible the ferry

18

rates for the carrying of agricultural products and livestock between Kodiak

19

and Homer from September 1 to April 1.
