5 Relating to regulations dealing with
6 brown and grizzly bear.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS the decline in the number of brown and grizzly bear in certain
9 game management units has given rise to the possibility of severe season
10 curtailments; and

11 WHEREAS the announcements by the Board of Fish and Game of these season
12 changes of curtailments were made less than six months in advance of the
13 normal season which poses great difficulties to those persons desiring to
14 hunt brown and grizzly bear; and

15 WHEREAS unlike other species of game, winter mortality studies play
16 no part in determining seasons for bear and thus the necessity for computing
17 these statistics is eliminated;

18 BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is respectfully requested to direct
19 the Board of Fish and Game to promulgate regulations dealing with brown and
20 grizzly bear seasons at least six months prior to the date they are to go
21 into effect.
