5 Relating to regulations dealing with
6 brown and grizzly bear.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS the decline in the number of brown and grizzly bear in certain
9 game management units has given rise to the possibility of severe season
10 curtailments; and

11 WHEREAS announcements by the Board of Fish and Game of these season
12 changes or curtailments if made less than six months in advance of the normal
13 season pose great difficulties to those persons desiring to hunt brown and
14 grizzly bear; and

15 WHEREAS unlike other species of game, winter mortality studies play
16 no part in determining seasons for bear and thus the necessity for computing
17 these statistics is eliminated;

18 BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Fish and Game is respectfully requested
19 to promulgate regulations dealing with brown and grizzly bear seasons at
20 least six months prior to the date they are to go into effect.
