BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS presently the Supreme Court of the state sits in three different  
9 locations; and

WHEREAS this practice results in duplication of law libraries and staff  
11 and does not lend itself to consultation or communication among the justices  
12 and

WHEREAS the general inefficiency and ineffectiveness of this practice  
14 will be compounded when two new justices are added to the court this year;  
15 and

WHEREAS sitting together in one location would promote clearer communi-  
17 cation among the members of the court and would greatly promote the over-all  
18 efficiency of the court;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Supreme Court of the State of Alaska is re-  
20 spectfully requested to improve present court practice by providing that the  
21 entire court sit together as a body in one location.
