3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA
4 FIFTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Relating to a radio communications net-
6 work on the village level.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS the lack of a dependable 24-hour radio communications network
9 in Alaska poses a serious health and safety problem; and

10 WHEREAS using a combination of radio services now provided by the
11 Bureau of Indian Affairs and the National Guard makes intervillage communica-
12 tion difficult or impossible; and

13 WHEREAS a state radio network linking each village in Alaska would be
14 of invaluable service in making possible weather reports, calls for medical
15 aid, and other services necessary to life and safety in these isolated
16 areas;

17 BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature respectfully requests the Governor
18 to direct the division of communications of the Department of Public Works
19 to inventory stationary radios, their frequencies and to establish an
20 integrated emergency radio network in Alaska.
