5 Relating to the late Andrew Hope.

6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

7 WHEREAS God, by His healing hand, has taken away the pain of suffering
8 by calling to Himself our beloved friend and former colleague, Andrew Hope;
9 and

10 WHEREAS Andrew Hope served as a Representative in this Legislature for
11 14 years - - 10 during territorial status, and the first four years of
12 Alaska's statehood; and

13 WHEREAS Andrew Hope was a Tlingit, of the Eagle tribe, and the Kag Wan
14 Toon Clan, a proud man and highly esteemed, he was first and foremost a
15 citizen of this great state, concerned with all its people; and

16 WHEREAS Andrew Hope was among the early organizers of the Alaska Native
17 Brotherhood and the Alaska Native Sisterhood, and served several terms as
18 President of the Grand Camp of the Alaska Native Brotherhood; and

19 WHEREAS Andrew Hope will be remembered for his exceptional leadership
20 and direction of his people, his dedicated service in the Legislature, and
21 enthusiastic participation in civic activities; and

22 WHEREAS his many friends are saddened by news of his passing;

23 BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature by this Resolution acknowledges
24 its loss of a close friend, respected colleague, and outstanding citizen,
25 and extends to his sorrowing family its deepest sympathy in their loss of
26 a devoted husband and father.
