2 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 6

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 FIFTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Relating to the location of fish pro-
6 tein concentrate manufacturing plants
7 in South Central Alaska.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS the Commissioner of the Food and Drug Administration has
10 approved the use of whole fish protein concentrate as a food additive; and

11 WHEREAS Congress has recently passed legislation authorizing the con-
12 struction of one fish protein concentrate manufacturing plant and the leas-
13 ing of a second, locations to be determined by the Secretary of the Inter-
14 ior; and

15 WHEREAS Alaska is one of the greatest fishing areas of the world and
16 as such is an ideal location for the operation of fish protein concentration
17 plants; and

18 WHEREAS production of fish protein concentrate in Alaska would greatly
19 benefit the economy of the state;

20 BE IT RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Interior is respectfully re-
21 quested to locate the fish protein concentrate manufacturing plants
22 authorized recently by Congress in South Central Alaska.
