2 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 19
3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA
4 FIFTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Relating to a dock-warehouse-cold
6 storage facility at Yakutat.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS the salmon fishery is the single most important industry in the
9 Yakutat area; and

10 WHEREAS the geographical location of Yakutat is highly favorable with
11 regard to Alaska's expanding bottom fishery; and

12 WHEREAS the recent timber sale in the Yakutat area and the introduction
13 of a timber industry make necessary adequate port facilities; and

14 WHEREAS the City of Yakutat has applied to the United States Economic
15 Development Administration for grant and loan funds for the purpose of
16 constructing a much needed dock-warehouse-cold storage facility; and

17 WHEREAS the City of Yakutat is endeavoring to answer a need for shore
18 based cold storage facilities which faces the fishing industry of the entire
19 state; and

20 WHEREAS a project of this type will increase the productivity of Alaska's
21 fishing industry as well as provide a port facility in the Yakutat area, thus
22 making economic development possible;

23 BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of the State of Alaska urges the
24 United States Economic Development Administration to approve the City of
25 Yakutat's application for a dock-warehouse-cold storage facility and make
26 funds available for the construction of the facility at the earliest possible
27 date.
