5 Relating to sale or lease of private  
6 recreational lands by the division of  
7 lands.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS private recreational lands, as classified by the division of  
10 lands, derive their chief value as private outdoor recreational areas to be  
11 used for limited noncommercial development; and

12 WHEREAS an excessive concentration of population or development impairs  
13 the character of these lands for private recreational purposes; and

14 WHEREAS in the judgment of the legislature sale or lease of contiguous  
15 and adjacent sites in connection with a wholesale disposition of private  
16 recreational lands risks permanent impairment of the value of the lands for  
17 recreational purposes;

18 BE IT RESOLVED that the legislature directs the division of lands, with  
19 respect to disposition of private recreational lands on a wholesale basis,  
20 to discontinue sale or lease of contiguous and adjacent sites and to permit  
21 such sale or lease only when a reasonable space intervenes between sites in  
22 order to preserve the private recreational value of the land; and be it

23 FURTHER RESOLVED that the legislature directs the division of lands to  
24 terminate any existing program conflicting with the intent of this request.
