2 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 46

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 FIFTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Relating to civilian use of the fuel
6 pipeline from Haines to Fairbanks.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS the cost of transporting fuel to the Fairbanks area is extremely
9 high and results in a high cost of living in that area; and

10 WHEREAS the military pipeline between Haines and Fairbanks could be
11 made available for civilian purposes since the military requirements do not
12 demand full time use; and

13 WHEREAS civilian use of this pipeline would result in a lower cost for
14 fuel in the Fairbanks area, would make possible an increase in general avia-
15 tion and additional air service, and would aid significantly in lowering
16 the cost of living in this area;

17 BE IT RESOLVED that the Secretary of Defense and the Commander-in-Chief
18 of the Alaska Command are requested to allow the pipeline between Haines and
19 Fairbanks to be used for the transportation of fuel for civilian purposes.

24 Gruening, U.S. Senators, and The Honorable Howard W. Pollock, U.S. Repre-
25 sentative, members of the Alaska delegation in Congress.
