BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the International North Pacific Fisheries Commission and its

11

Advisory Committee can render an invaluable service to the State of Alaska

12

and the countries which border the North Pacific Ocean by resolving the

13

many and difficult fisheries problems by which they are faced; and

14

WHEREAS this commission and its advisory committee can successfully

15

carry out its important and pressing tasks only so long as they are composed

16

of dedicated, farsighted, knowledgeable and conscientious men; and

17

WHEREAS, because he has long been a fisherman and thus able to under-

18

stand the fisheries problems; because he is a legislator and thus able to

19

act as a source of information and consultation to legislators and the public

20

in an area which is of vital concern; and because he is a man who has

21

acquired the greatest respect from both the American and foreign members of

22

the commission, and is the Vice Chairman of the American Section of the

23

advisory Committee, the people of Alaska and the Nation are extremely fortunate

24

in having Representative Clem Tillion as one of their representatives on the

25

committee; and

WHEREAS, in an attempt to become better informed and effective, Repre-

27

sentative Tillion has taken it upon himself to learn the language, culture

28

and history of the people with whom he deals; and

WHEREAS it is the understanding of the Alaska Legislature that the

1 Governor has submitted to Mr. Clarence F. Pautzke, Commissioner, Fish and  
2 Wildlife Service, the names of a Deputy Commissioner of the Alaska Depart-  
3 ment of Fish and Game and the State Director of International Fisheries to  
4 fill the one existing vacancy and to replace a present member;

5 BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska Legislature respectfully requests  
6 Mr. Clarence F. Pautzke to retain Representative Clem Tillion as a member of  
7 the International North Pacific Fisheries Commission Advisory Committee.

9 Udall, Secretary of the Department of the Interior; The Honorable Clarence  
10 F. Pautzke, Commissioner, Fish and Wildlife Service; and to The Honorable  
11 E. L. Bartlett and The Honorable Ernest Gruening, U. S. Senators, and The  
12 Honorable Howard W. Pollock, U. S. Representative, members of the Alaska  
13 delegation in Congress.
