5 Relating to a weather station at
6 Fairbanks.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS weather information gathered in Fairbanks is sent to the
9 Anchorage Weather Bureau before it is interpreted and relayed back to
10 Fairbanks for dissemination; and

11 WHEREAS this procedure causes unnecessary aggravations and delays in
12 the dissemination of weather information;

13 BE IT RESOLVED that the Weather Bureau is respectfully urged to
14 establish a full fledged weather station at Fairbanks to eliminate any need
15 for a relay of weather information to Anchorage before it is disseminated
16 in the Fairbanks area.
