3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 FIFTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Relating to the creation of a marine
6 science college at Seward.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:

8 WHEREAS marine resources, including animal and vegetable life and
9 mineral wealth, constitute a far-reaching and largely untapped asset of
10 immense potential significance to the State of Alaska and to the United
11 States; and

12 WHEREAS aquaculture, as with agriculture on land, and the gainful use
13 of marine resources can substantially benefit the State of Alaska, the
14 United States, and ultimately the people of the world, by providing greater
15 economic opportunities, including expanded employment and commerce, the
16 enjoyment and use of our marine resources, new sources of food, and new
17 means for the development of marine resources; and

18 WHEREAS the federal government has recently provided for the support
19 of marine research programs in Public Law 89-688;

20 BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Regents of the University of Alaska
21 is requested to create a marine science college and oceanographic research
22 center in Seward as part of the institute of marine sciences.
