5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act increasing the amount of assistance to
7 dependent children."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 47.25.320(a) is amended to read:

10 (a) The department shall determine the amount of assistance for
11 a dependent child and the relative with whom the dependent child is
12 living, with regard to the resources and necessary expenditures of the
13 family and the condition existing in each case. Assistance is suffi-
14 cient if, when added to all other income and support available to the
15 child, the child and relative have reasonable subsistence compatible
16 with decency and health.

17 (1) However, the amount of assistance shall not exceed

18 (A) \$125 when there is a relative and one child that
19 has not reached five years of age,

20 (B) \$150 when there is a relative and one child that
21 is at least five but less than 13 years of age,

22 (C) \$175 when there is a relative and one child that
23 is at least 13 but less than 18 years of age;

24 (2) If there is more than one child the amount allowed for
25 each additional child shall not exceed

26 (A) \$50 if the additional child has not reached five
27 years of age,

28 (B) \$75 if the additional child is at least five but
29 less than 13 years of age,

1 (C) \$100 if the additional child is at least 13 but
2 less than 18 years of age.

3 [\$105, WHEN THERE IS A RELATIVE AND ONE CHILD. IF THERE IS MORE THAN
4 ONE CHILD, THE AMOUNT ALLOWED FOR THE RELATIVE AND FIRST CHILD SHALL
5 NOT EXCEED \$105, AND THE AMOUNT FOR EACH ADDITIONAL CHILD SHALL NOT
6 EXCEED \$40.]
