SIXTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to firearm purchases by residents in contiguous states."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. PURPOSE. The purpose of this Act is to comply with Pub. Law 90-618, sec. 922(b)(3)(A).

* Sec. 2. AS 11.55 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 11.55.080. PURCHASE OF FIREARMS BY RESIDENTS IN CONTIGUOUS STATES. No resident of this state is prohibited from purchasing a rifle or shotgun in a contiguous state if he complies with the provisions of Pub. Law 90-618 and the state law or published ordinance at the place of sale.
