6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the destruction, alteration, or
7 concealment of evidence."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 11.30 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 11.30.315. DESTROYING, ALTERING, OR CONCEALING EVIDENCE.

11 A person who wilfully destroys, alters, or conceals evidence concerning
12 the commission of a crime or evidence which is being sought for pro-
13 duction during an investigation, inquiry, or trial, with the intent to
14 prevent the evidence from being discovered or produced, is guilty of a
15 misdemeanor, and upon conviction is punishable by imprisonment for not
16 more than one year, or by a fine of not more than \$1,000, or by both.
