5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the Japanese World Fair of 1970;  
7 granting powers and duties necessary to an Alaska  
8 exhibit; and providing for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. This Act authorizes and directs the construction and opera-  
11 tion of an Alaska exhibit in the Japanese World Fair of 1970. All powers  
12 and authority necessary to the accomplishment of this project are granted  
13 by this Act to any department of the state which can contribute assistance  
14 or skills.

15 \* Sec. 2. DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT. The Department of  
16 Economic Development shall

17 (1) plan and administer all official state activities leading  
18 up to and relating to the 1970 Japanese World Fair;

19 (2) solicit, encourage, and foster participation by Alaska  
20 business firms, individuals, and organizations in the Alaska exhibit;

21 (3) have the power to enter into agreements for use or rental  
22 of space within the exhibit building on such terms and conditions as  
23 the commissioner of economic development may consider reasonable and  
24 consistent with sharing the financial burden to the state of the  
25 exhibit;

26 (4) use its facilities and best efforts to obtain the co-  
27 operation and support of individuals, organizations, political sub-  
28 divisions, and business firms in the Alaska exhibit so that the  
29 public is fully informed as to the nature of the exhibit;

1 (5) have the power to hire personnel necessary for staffing  
2 the exhibit and for carrying out its duties established by this Act,  
3 who shall be in the partially exempt service under AS 39.25.120.

4 \* Sec. 3. DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS. The Department of Public Works  
5 shall

6 (1) investigate and be responsible for the design, con-  
7 struction, maintenance, and destruction of the exhibit building and  
8 site improvements;

9 (2) be responsible for the selection of an Alaska architect;

10 (3) do all things necessary to the accomplishment of the  
11 purpose of this act.

12 \* Sec. 4. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and  
13 approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
