6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to qualifications of an assistant
7 adjutant general."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 26.05.180 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 26.05.180. HEADQUARTERS STAFF OF ALASKA NATIONAL GUARD. (a)
11 The headquarters of the Alaska National Guard is composed of an Army
12 National Guard component and an Air National Guard component. The Army
13 National Guard component and the Air National Guard component shall each
14 be commanded by an assistant adjutant general appointed by the adjutant
15 general with the concurrence of the governor. An assistant adjutant
16 general shall, while holding office,, have the grade of brigadier
17 general or lower grade which the adjutant general may prescribe and
18 must at least hold a federally recognized field-grade commission with
19 five years service in the Alaska Army or Air National Guard on initial
20 appointment.

21 (b) The adjutant general may appoint necessary officers, enlisted
22 men, and civilian employees to the headquarters staff.
