6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to qualifications of an assistant
7 adjutant general."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 26.05.180 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 26.05.180. HEADQUARTERS STAFF OF ALASKA NATIONAL GUARD. (a)
11 The headquarters of the Alaska National Guard is composed of an Army
12 National Guard component and an Air National Guard component. The
13 Army National Guard component and the Air National Guard component
14 shall each be commanded by an assistant adjutant general appointed by
15 the adjutant general with the concurrence of the governor. An
16 assistant adjutant general shall, while holding office, have the grade
17 of brigadier general or lower grade which the adjutant general may
18 prescribe and must at least hold a federally recognised field-grade
19 commission with five years service in the Alaska Army, National Guard
20 or the Air National Guard on initial appointment.

21 (b) The adjutant general may appoint necessary officers,
22 enlisted men, and civilian employees to the headquarters staff.

23 * Sec. 2. The requirement of five years service in Alaska shall not
24 apply to those officers occupying the positions of assistant adjutant
25 general of the Alaska Army National Guard and Alaska Air National Guard
26 on the effective date of this Act.
