6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to apprentice and journeyman barbers;
7 and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 08.12.070 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

10 Sec. 08.12.070. APPRENTICE BARBERS. A person shall be licensed
11 as an apprentice barber if he

12 (1) submits to the board evidence of good moral character;
13 previous conviction of a felony or misdemeanor shall not be conclusive
14 evidence that the person does not have good moral character;

15 (2) completes a course of study and receives a diploma from
16 a licensed barber school or college in the state or a board approved
17 school outside the state;

18 (3) submits to the board a certificate of health from a
19 physician; and

20 (4) applies to the board for apprentice examination within
21 two weeks of graduation from barber college, and passes the apprentice
22 examination administered by the board.

23 * Sec. 2. AS 08.12 is amended by adding new sections to read:

24 Sec. 08.12.075. FAILURE TO PASS OR APPLY FOR APPRENTICE EXAMINA-
25 TION. A person who fails to apply for examination within the time
26 required by sec. 70(4) of this chapter, or who fails the examination
27 may be required by the board to take or retake further courses at an
28 accredited barber school or college as specified by the board, and is
29 not eligible for re-examination for a period of 60 days.

1 Sec. 08.12.077. JOURNEYMAN BARBERS. (a) A person shall be
2 licensed as a journeyman barber if he

3 (1) presents evidence satisfactory to the board at the time
4 of applying for the journeyman examination that he has been employed as
5 an apprentice barber under the immediate personal supervision of a
6 journeyman barber for a period of at least 12 months;

7 (2) applies for and passes a journeyman barber examination
8 administered by the board; and

9 (3) is presently licensed as a barber under AS 08.12 on
10 the effective date of this Act.

11 (b) A person who fails the examination required by (a) of this
12 section shall be required to work further as an apprentice barber for
13 a period of six months and present evidence of this employment to the
14 board before applying for re-examination.

15 * Sec. 3. AS 08.12.080 is amended to read:

16 Sec. 08.12.080. EXAMINATION FEES. An applicant for examination
17 shall submit with his application an examination fee as follows:

- 18 (1) examination for apprentice or journeyman bar
19 ber license \$25
20 (2) examination for barber teacher license \$75
21 (3) application fee \$20

22 * Sec. 4. AS 08.12.090 is amended to read:

23 Sec. 08.12.090. LICENSE FEE FOR BARBERS. The biennial [ANNUAL]
24 fee for an apprentice or journeyman [A] license to engage in barbering
25 is \$20 [\$10].

26 * Sec. 5. AS 08.12 is amended by adding new sections to read:

27 Sec. 08.12.255. MANAGERS OF SHOPS. The manager of each barber
28 shop shall hold a journeyman barber license.

29 Sec. 08.12.257. FURNISHING FALSE INFORMATION. The board may

1 revoke or suspend the license of a licensed barber who presents false
2 evidence as to the employment of an apprentice barber.

3 * Sec. 6. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and
4 approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
