5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act providing for a college expense deduction in
7 the state income tax."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 43.20.010(c) is amended by adding a new paragraph to
10 read:

11 (9) A taxpayer 25 years of age or under, or a taxpayer
12 having a legal dependent 25 years of age or under, is entitled to
13 a deduction for the college expenses of the taxpayer or legal dependent.
14 The maximum amount allowable under this deduction is \$1,000 per student.
15 To qualify for a deduction under this paragraph the student must be a
16 bona fide college student, including graduate student, attending an
17 accredited university or college within the State of Alaska.
