6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to harmful or dangerous substances."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 \* Section 1. AS 18.60 is amended by adding new sections to read:

9 ARTICLE 6. HARMFUL OR DANGEROUS SUBSTANCES.

10 Sec. 18.60.580. EMPLOYMENT OF LICENSED PERSONS REQUIRED IN  
11 CERTAIN INSTANCES. (a) No person may weld, weld on, fabricate or in  
12 any other manner construct or build a pipe line, tank, vessel or other  
13 unit used, either temporarily or permanently in the state, in the  
14 commercial production, conveyance or storage of flammable, poisonous,  
15 caustic or corrosive liquids, gasses or chemicals, the failure of  
16 which unit or the escape or spillage of which substance would be harm-  
17 ful or dangerous to human life, wildlife or property, unless the  
18 person has been tested, certified and licensed by the state to perform  
19 this type of work.

20 (b) This section applies to the prefabrication, completely or in  
21 part, of any unit that requires completion, hook-up or installation  
22 in the state.

23 (c) This section does not apply to products manufactured by  
24 licensed manufacturing firms which produce these units on a volume  
25 scale.

26 Sec. 18.60.590. PENALTIES. (a) A person who violates sec. 580  
27 of this chapter is, upon conviction, punishable by a fine of not less  
28 than \$300 nor more than \$1,000, or by imprisonment for not less than  
29 30 days nor more than one year, or by both.

1 (b) A partnership, company, corporation or other employer which  
2 instructs or permits an owner, part owner, supervisor, inspector or  
3 employee to violate sec. 580 of this chapter is, upon conviction,  
4 punishable by a fine of not less than \$1,000 nor more than \$10,000,  
5 or by revocation of the license to operate in the state, or by both.  
6 Prosecution may be had and penalties may be levied against the partner-  
7 ship, company, corporation or employer, collectively or individually.
