6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the rate of the annual license  
7 tax on vehicles containing mobile amateur radio  
8 stations."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. AS 28.10.200(b)(2) is amended to read:

11 (2) except as provided in (b)(7) and (b)(8) of this section,  
12 for a motor vehicle not designed, used, or maintained primarily for  
13 the transportation of passengers or property for hire, \$30;

14 \* Sec. 2. AS 28.10.200(b)(7) is amended to read:

15 (7) for a mobile amateur radio station for which special  
16 registration plates are issued, the applicant, in recognition of his  
17 service to the public, shall not pay any [AN] additional charges [CHARGE]  
18 for special registration plates, provided he annually files his regis-  
19 tration before November 1; in addition to the requirements of sec. 50  
20 (a)(5) of this chapter, the station must be satisfactorily proved  
21 capable of being utilized 24 hours a day, must have a transceiver  
22 capable of operating on 75 meters through 10 meters, must have an  
23 antenna, and must have a power supply and wiring as a permanent part  
24 of the vehicle. The transmitting unit may be removed from the car for  
25 service or dry storage. The annual license tax is \$1 for mobile amateur  
26 radio station vehicles included in (b)(2) or (8) of this section, pro-  
27 vided the annual registration is filed before November 1;
