6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to workmen's compensation; and
7 providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 23.30.175 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 23.30.175. RATES OF COMPENSATION. (a) Compensation for
11 temporary disability or permanent partial disability may not exceed
12 \$150 [~~\$113~~] a week and may not be less than \$25 a week. If the
13 employee's average weekly wages, as computed under sec. 220 of this
14 chapter, are less than \$25 a week, he shall receive as compensation
15 for temporary disability his average weekly wages.

16 (b) In computing compensation for permanent total disability the
17 average weekly wages are considered to have been not more than \$150
18 [~~\$113~~]. If the average weekly wages as computed under sec. 220 of
19 this chapter are less than \$25 a week he shall receive as compensation
20 for permanent total disability his average weekly wages.

21 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and
22 approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
