6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the liquor license/population
7 ratio."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 04.10.210 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 04.10.210. POPULATION LIMITATIONS ON ISSUANCE OF NEW LICENSE.

11 Unless otherwise provided, no application for a new license shall be
12 approved for any location

13 (1) outside an incorporated town where the total of licensed
14 premises in the aggregate at one time would exceed one license of each
15 type for each 3,000 [1,500] population or fraction thereof within a
16 radius of five miles of the proposed location;

17 (2) within an incorporated city where the total of licensed
18 premises in the aggregate at one time would exceed one license of each
19 type for each 3,000 [1,500] population or fraction thereof within the
20 city.

21 * Sec. 2. AS 04.10.240 is amended to read:

22 Sec. 04.10.240. TRANSFER OF LICENSE. No license issued under
23 this title may be transferred except after first securing the consent
24 of the board. No license may be transferred out of the election dis-
25 trict for the house of representatives within which it was granted or
26 into an area that exceeds one license of each type for each 3,000
27 [1,500] population or fraction thereof. Licenses already issued [ON
28 APRIL 25, 1960,] shall be renewed irrespective of this ratio, unless
29 the application is denied for reason other than that contained in this
