6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the number of superior court
7 judges."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 22.10.120 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 22.10.120. NUMBER OF JUDGES. The superior court consists
11 of 13 [11] judges, two of whom shall be judges in the first judicial
12 district, one of whom shall be judge in the second judicial district,
13 seven [SIX] of whom shall be judges in the third judicial district,
14 and three [TWO] of whom shall be judges in the fourth judicial district.
15 At the time of submitting the names of nominees to the governor to fill
16 a vacancy on the superior court bench, the judicial council shall also
17 designate the district in which the appointee is to reside and serve.

18 * Sec. 2. One superior court judge in the third judicial district shall
19 serve full time in the City of Kodiak. One superior court judge in the
20 fourth judicial district shall have primary responsibility for matters
21 arising under AS 47.10 and he shall serve full time in the City of Fairbanks.
