6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to Native scholarships."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 14.40.520 is amended to read:

9 Sec. 14.40.520. SCHOLARSHIPS. The Board of Regents of the
10 University of Alaska shall offer not more than 25 [15] new scholarships
11 for each academic year to Alaska Natives desiring to attend the Univer-
12 sity of Alaska. The board shall give preference to Natives residing
13 in the rural areas of the state who desire to receive training in the
14 field of education. If there are more than 25 [15] applications the
15 board shall award 25 [15] scholarships to those applicants who have
16 the highest scholastic record or who the board determines are the most
17 qualified among the applicants and who are financially unable to obtain
18 a higher education without assistance. The University shall provide
19 such minimum financial assistance to these students as is necessary in
20 each individual case, but not exceeding fees, board and room.
