6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to cooperative arrangements made
7 by school districts; and providing for an effective
8 date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 14.14.110 is amended to read:

11 Sec. 14.14.110. COOPERATION WITH OTHER DISTRICTS. (a) When
12 necessary to provide more efficient or more economical educational
13 services, a district may cooperate with other districts, state-
14 operated schools, or the Bureau of Indian Affairs in providing educa-
15 tional services or in establishing boarding and tuition arrangements,
16 arrangements for the exchange of pupils or teachers, or other similar
17 arrangements. However, if a cooperative arrangement requires pupils
18 to live away from their usual homes, the school board shall provide
19 classes within the district for any grade represented by more than
20 three elementary pupils or five secondary pupils.

21 (b) Upon approval by the commissioner of a district plan for
22 cooperative arrangements, the department may grant to the district
23 50 per cent of the costs of implementing the plan as matching funds
24 for federal, district or other money used to implement the plan. The
25 commissioner shall require an annual accounting of funds received by
26 a district under this subsection and may prescribe additional require-
27 ments as he deems necessary governing approval of applications under
28 this subsection.

29 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect July 1, 1969.
