6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the use of herring."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 16.10 is amended by adding a new section to read:

9 Sec. 16.10.165. USE OF HERRING. No person may take herring
10 in the waters of the state for any purpose except for use as bait
11 or as food for human consumption.

12 * Sec. 2. AS 16.10.170 is amended to read:

13 Sec. 16.10.170. PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION OF SECTIONS 140 - 165
14 [160] OF THIS CHAPTER. A person who violates Secs. 140 - 165 [160] of
15 this chapter is guilty of a misdemeanor and is punishable by imprison-
16 ment for not more than six months or by a fine of not more than
17 \$1,000, or by both.
