6 For an Act entitled: "An Act providing for the placing of revenue derived  
7 from the sale of sea otter pelts into the general  
8 revenue fund."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. AS 16.05.110 is amended to read:

11 Sec. 16.05.110. COMPOSITION OF FUND. (a) Except as provided  
12 in (b) of this section the [THE] fish and game fund shall be made  
13 up of the following money and other money the legislature appropriates,  
14 which shall be deposited and retained in the fund until expended:

- 15 (1) money received from the sale of state sport fishing  
16 and hunting licenses and special permits;
- 17 (2) proceeds received from the sale of furs, skins and  
18 specimens taken by predator hunters and other employees;
- 19 (3) money received in settlement of a claim or loss caused  
20 by damage to the fish and game resources of the state;
- 21 (4) money received from federal, state, or other govern-  
22 mental unit, or from a private donor for fish and game purposes;
- 23 (5) interest earned upon money in the fund;
- 24 (6) money from any other source.

25 (b) Revenue accumulated from the sale of sea otter pelts shall  
26 be placed in the general revenue fund.
