6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the administration of public
7 schools."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 14.07.170 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

10 (3) establish public school attendance areas without respect
11 to school district boundaries.

12 * Sec. 2. AS 14.07.020 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

13 (8) require chief school administrators to maintain a
14 current course outline, to be prepared in accordance with a format
15 provided by the commissioner, for each subject offered in district
16 secondary schools, and copies of all course outlines shall be trans-
17 mitted to the commissioner.

18 * Sec. 3. AS 14.14.130 is amended to read:

19 Sec. 14.14.130. CHIEF SCHOOL ADMINISTRATOR [SUPERINTENDENT OF
20 SCHOOLS]. (a) Each school board shall select and employ a qualified
21 person as the chief administrator [SUPERINTENDENT] of schools for the
22 district.

23 (b) The chief school administrator [SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS IS
24 THE CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER] of the district [AND] shall administer
25 the district in accordance with the policies which the school board
26 prescribes by bylaw.

27 (c) The chief school administrator [SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS]
28 shall select, appoint, and otherwise control all school district
29 employees [AND ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICERS] serving under him subject to the

1 approval of the school board.

2 * Sec. 4. AS 14.14.140(b) is amended to read:

3 (b) Members of the immediate family of a chief school administra-
4 tor [SUPERINTENDENT] may not be employed by the chief school administra-
5 tor [SUPERINTENDENT] except upon approval of the commissioner.
