6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the education of exceptional  
7 children within the state."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 14.30.285 is repealed.

10 \* Sec. 2. AS 14.30 is amended by adding a new section to read:

11 Sec. 14.30.287. EXCEPTIONAL PUPILS WITHIN THE STATE. (a) An  
12 exceptional child may be sent to another school district or state-oper-  
13 ated school if the child resides in a district or school attendance  
14 area where there is no provision for classes or the special education  
15 class is not appropriate for the needs of the child.

16 (b) If a school district or the commissioner, if a state-operated  
17 school, approves the enrollment of an exceptional child in another  
18 school district or state-operated school approved by the commissioner,  
19 and the child is enrolled in the institution, the child's education  
20 expenses shall be paid for as follows:

21 (1) the school district or the Department of Education shall  
22 pay the receiving district an amount of money equal to the receiving  
23 district's local cost per pupil rate;

24 (2) the Department of Education shall pay the remainder of  
25 the annual cost of the child's education above that provided for in  
26 (b)(1) of this section.

27 (c) For the purposes of this section a child's education expenses  
28 are limited to the cost of the pupil's annual transportation to and  
29 from his destination and the actual cost of necessary care, including

1 room and board, while attending the designated institution.
