6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the Alcoholic Beverage Control
7 Board."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 04.05.010(a) is amended to read:

10 (a) There is established an Alcoholic Beverage Control Board
11 within the Department of Revenue consisting of five [THREE] members
12 appointed for overlapping three-year terms. The board is vested with
13 the duties, powers, and responsibilities involved in the control of
14 alcoholic beverages, including the promulgation of rules and regulations
15 and the hearing of appeals from the action of officers and employees
16 charged with enforcing the alcoholic beverage control laws, rules, and
17 regulations. The governor shall appoint the board subject to con-
18 firmation by the legislature. No member of the board may hold any
19 other state or federal office, either elective or appointive. Two
20 members [ONE MEMBER] of the board shall be actively engaged in the
21 alcoholic beverage industry. No three [TWO] members of the board may
22 be engaged in the same business, occupation or profession. Three [TWO]
23 members shall constitute a quorum for the conduct of business. The
24 board shall meet at least once each year in each of the four judicial
25 districts to study, reconsider and modify existing agency rules and
26 regulations in the light of current local problems.
