6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the Alcoholic Beverage Control
7 Board."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 04.05.010(a) is amended to read:

10 (a) There is established an Alcoholic Beverage Control Board
11 within the Department of Revenue consisting of five [THREE] members
12 appointed for overlapping three-year terms. The board is vested with
13 the duties, powers, and responsibilities involved in the control of
14 alcoholic beverages, including the promulgation of rules and regulations
15 and the hearing of appeals from the action of officers and employees
16 charged with enforcing the alcoholic beverage control laws, rules, and
17 regulations. The governor shall appoint the board subject to confirma-
18 tion by the legislature. No member of the board may hold any other
19 state or federal office, either elective or appointive. Two members
20 [ONE MEMBER] of the board shall be actively engaged in the alcoholic
21 beverage industry, except that no member may be an officer, agent, or
22 employee of a wholesale alcoholic beverage enterprise. No three [TWO]
23 members of the board may be engaged in the same business, occupation or
24 profession. Three [TWO] members shall constitute a quorum for the
25 conduct of business. The board shall meet at least once each year in
26 each of the four judicial districts to study, reconsider and modify
27 existing agency rules and regulations in the light of current local
28 problems.

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
