6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to small claims courts."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 22.15.040 is amended to read:

9 Sec. 22.15.040. SMALL CLAIMS. When a claim for relief does not
10 exceed \$1,000 [\$500] exclusive of costs, interest and attorney fees
11 and request is so made, the district judge [MAGISTRATE] or [DEPUTY]
12 magistrate shall hear the action as a small claim unless important or
13 unusual points of law are involved. The supreme court shall prescribe
14 the procedural rules and standard forms to assure simplicity and the
15 expeditious handling of small claims.
