6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to compensation of judicial officers,
7 state officers and employees; and providing for an effe-
8 tive date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 22.05.140(a) is amended to read:

11 (a) The chief justice shall receive \$30,000 [\$27,000] annually,
12 and each associate justice shall receive \$28,000 [\$26,000] annually as
13 compensation. The compensation is payable monthly in 12 equal install-
14 ments. Compensation of the chief justice or of an associate justice
15 shall not be diminished during his term of office, unless by general
16 law applying to all salaried officers of the state.

17 * Sec. 2. AS 22.10.190(a) is amended to read:

18 (a) Each superior court judge shall receive \$26,500 [\$23,000]
19 annually, as compensation, payable monthly in 12 equal installments.
20 The compensation of a judge shall not be diminished during his term of
21 office, unless by general law applying to all salaried officers of the
22 state.

23 * Sec. 3. AS 22.15.220(a) is repealed and re-enacted to read:

24 (a) Each district judge shall receive \$19,000 annually as com-
25 pensation, payable monthly in 12 equal installments.

26 * Sec. 4. AS 39.20.010 is amended to read:

27 Sec. 39.20.010. ANNUAL SALARY OF GOVERNOR. The annual salary of
28 the governor is \$32,000 [\$27,500]. The salary shall be paid in equal
29 monthly installments.

1 * Sec. 5. AS 39.20.030 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

2 Sec. 39.20.030. ANNUAL SALARY OF SECRETARY OF STATE. The
3 annual salary of the secretary of state is \$28,500. The salary shall
4 be paid in equal monthly installments.

5 * Sec. 6. AS 39.20.080 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

6 Sec. 39.20.080. SALARY OF EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENT HEAD AND DEPUTY.

7 (a) The annual salary of the head of each principal executive depart-
8 ment of the state upon appointment and confirmation is \$27,500. This
9 salary shall be paid in equal monthly installments.

10 (b) The monthly salary of the deputy head of each principal
11 executive department of the state, upon his appointment shall be not
12 less than step A, range 28, nor shall it exceed step C, range 28, of
13 salary schedule I, set out in AS 39.27.010(1), during the term of his
14 appointment.

Sec. 39.27.020. PAY INCREMENTS IN REMOTE LOCATIONS. The following pay increments are approved under AS 39.25.150(2) as an amendment to the pay plan for employees of the state.

(1) Permanent employees assigned to permanent duty stations at locations more than 100 miles from the Ketchikan, Juneau, Anchorage, or Fairbanks city boundary and which are accessible to one of the above cities by road, railroad, or ferry shall be paid at a rate in the appropriate salary schedule one step higher than [THREE PER CENT ABOVE] the pay provided by sec. 10 of this chapter.

(2) Permanent employees assigned to permanent duty stations at locations which are not accessible to Ketchikan, Juneau, Anchorage, or Fairbanks by road, railroad, or ferry shall be paid at a rate in the appropriate salary schedule two steps higher than [SIX PER CENT

1 ABOVE] the pay provided by sec. 10 of this chapter.

2 (3) The commissioner of the Department of Administration
3 shall promulgate regulations designating permanent duty stations which
4 are eligible for pay increments under this section.
