5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act providing for teacher aides."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 14.17.040 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

9 (4) the teacher aide salary allotment in sec. 55 of this
10 chapter.

11 * Sec. 2. AS 14.17 is amended by adding a new section to read:

12 Sec. 14.17.055^Y TEACHER AIDE SALARY ALLOTMENT. (a) Each district
13 with a commissioner-approved training program for teacher aides and
14 instructional staff is entitled to one teacher aide for each attendance
15 center as defined in sec. 70 of this chapter and an additional teacher
16 aide for each 75 students.

17 (b) The allotment shall be 75 per cent of the actual salary of
18 teacher aides up to the number of aides authorized, and may not exceed
19 \$3,000 for each aide.

20 (c) If in a fiscal year sufficient funds are not available to
21 finance the full number of teacher aides provided for in (a) of this
22 section, the commissioner shall determine the number of aides to which
23 a district is entitled for that year.

24 * Sec. 3. AS 14.17.250 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

25 (13) "teacher aide" means a noncertificated staff member
26 who directly assists the certificated staff in the establishment and
27 implementation of relevant programs and experiences essential to the
28 varying needs of pupils.
