6 For an Act entitled: "An Act abolishing daylight saving time in Alaska,  
7 under Sec. 3(a) of the Federal Uniform Time Act of  
8 1966."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. AS 01 is amended by adding a new chapter to read:

11 CHAPTER 15. TIME.

12 Sec. 01.15.010. STANDARD TIME. The standards of time specified  
13 for Alaska in the Federal Uniform Time Act of 1966 (Public Law 89-387;  
14 80 Stat. 107; 15 U.S.C. 260 et seq.), with the zone limits defined by  
15 the Interstate Commerce Commission under that Act, apply throughout  
16 the year in this state without the advance in time (commonly known as  
17 daylight saving time) set out in sec. 3(a) of that Act. All offices  
18 and departments of the state government, all city and borough govern-  
19 ments, whether home rule or otherwise, and every person operating or  
20 maintaining a place of business or engaged in business activity shall  
21 use the appropriate standard of time.

22 \* Sec. 2. If the Federal Uniform Time Act of 1966 is amended to permit  
23 a state situated within more than one time zone to use daylight saving time  
24 for less than all of its zones, that portion of Alaska on Pacific Standard  
25 Time shall annually use Pacific Daylight Time for the period prescribed  
26 in that Act, beginning in the year following the amendment.
