6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to compensation for accrued sick  
7 leave; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 39.20.260(a) is amended to read:

10 (a) Officers and employees are entitled to sick leave with pay  
11 which accrues at the rate of one and one-quarter days for each full  
12 monthly pay period. Sick leave which is not used during the year in  
13 which it accrues accumulates and is available for use in succeeding  
14 years or, at the option of the employee, shall be compensated for at  
15 the end of the calendar year by paying the employee for one-half of  
16 the accrued sick leave at the rate of his highest base pay during the  
17 calendar year in which the sick leave accrued.

18 \* Sec. 2. AS 39.20.260(e) is repealed.

19 \* Sec. 3. Nothing in this Act shall be construed so that compensation is  
20 allowed for sick leave which accrued before the effective date of this Act.

21 \* Sec. 4. The provisions of this Act are retroactive to January 1, 1969.

22 \* Sec. 5. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval  
23 or on the day it becomes law without approval.
