6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the sale of land to persons en-
7 gaged in shore fisheries."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 38.05.066 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 38.05.066. PREFERENCE TO PERSONS FOR FISHERY PURPOSES. When,
11 in the judgment of the director with the concurrence of the commissioner,
12 it is determined that it would be in the best interest of the state
13 and reasonably necessary for the use and enjoyment of a shore fishery
14 location [LEASE], the director may sell an uplands tract of land not
15 to exceed five acres to the person engaged in the fishery [LESSEE].
16 The price of the land shall be determined by the director based on the
17 fair market value of the tract at the time of original entry [THE
18 TRANSACTION]. In order for a shore fishery lessee to be eligible to
19 purchase under this section, he must be presently in actual or construc-
20 tive occupancy of a site which was originally sanctioned by a small
21 tracts lease from the federal government which has since been transferred
22 to the jurisdiction of the state.
