6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to eligibility for veterans' loans."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 \* Section 1. AS 26.15.130(a)(1) is amended to read:

9 (1) persons who served in the armed forces of the United  
10 States [FOR 90 DAYS OR MORE, OR WHOSE SERVICE WAS FOR LESS THAN 90 DAYS  
11 BECAUSE OF INJURY OR DISABILITY INCURRED IN THE LINE OF DUTY,] between  
12 April 6, 1917, and November 11, 1918, and September 16, 1940, and July  
13 25, 1947, or in a combat zone during any period of armed conflict, who  
14 were separated from the armed forces with a discharge other than dis-  
15 honorable, and

16 (A) who, at the time of induction into the service,  
17 were residents of the territory, who had been residents for not  
18 less than one year immediately before their induction, and who  
19 returned to the territory or state after discharge as residents  
20 with the intention of remaining in the territory or state; or

21 (B) who, not being bona fide residents of the territory  
22 before their entry into the service, have lived in the territory  
23 or state for at least 10 years following their release from active  
24 military service;

25 \* Sec. 2. AS 26.15.130(a)(2)(B) is amended to read:

26 (B) he served in the armed forces [FOR AT LEAST 90 DAYS]  
27 between September 16, 1949, and July 25, 1947, but no benefits  
28 for loans accrue to dependents of an enlistee or re-enlistee for  
29 time served after November 1, 1945, regardless of whether the

1 enlistment or re-enlistment was before or after November 1, 1945;

3 \* Sec. 3. AS 26.15.160(1)(C) is amended to read:

4 (C) who served in the armed forces of the United States  
5 [FOR 90 DAYS OR MORE, OR WHOSE SERVICE WAS FOR A LESSER PERIOD  
6 BECAUSE OF INJURY OR DISABILITY INCURRED IN LINE OF DUTY,] between  
7 June 25, 1950, and January 31, 1955, or who served in the armed  
8 forces of the United States [FOR 90 DAYS OR MORE OR WHOSE SERVICE  
9 WAS FOR A LESSER PERIOD BECAUSE OF INJURY OR DISABILITY INCURRED  
10 IN LINE OF DUTY,] between August 4, 1964, and a date to be de-  
11 termined by the legislature which shall be on or about six months  
12 after the termination of hostilities involving forces of the  
13 United States in Vietnam [VIET NAM].
