6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to relief and rescue parties; and  
7 providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 18.60.130 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 18.60.130. EXPENSES OF RELIEF AND RESCUE PARTIES. The  
11 expense of the relief and rescue party shall be paid out of the state  
12 treasury upon vouchers properly made out and signed and sworn to by the  
13 person appointed to direct the rescue and relief party. The oath to  
14 the voucher shall be taken and made before the magistrate who appoints  
15 the person and may be paid only after it has been approved by the  
16 commissioner of public safety or his designee [GOVERNOR]. In approving  
17 the voucher, the commissioner of public safety or his designee [GOVERNOR]  
18 shall consider the necessity of the relief and rescue party, the  
19 reasonableness of the expenses and the proper audit of the voucher.  
20 The commissioner of public safety [GOVERNOR] shall adopt rules and  
21 regulations for the guidance of magistrates governing the authorization  
22 of rescue and relief parties and of their expenses.

23 \* Sec. 2. AS 18.60.140 is amended to read:

24 Sec. 18.60.140. LIMITATION OF AMOUNT OF EXPENDITURE FOR RESCUE  
25 OR RELIEF. A magistrate may [NOT] obligate the state in an amount up  
26 to \$750 [EXCEEDING \$250] in any one case of rescue and relief [, UNLESS  
27 HE FIRST OBTAINS THE APPROVAL OF THE GOVERNOR]. If the commissioner of  
28 public safety or his designee [GOVERNOR] approves, he shall state the  
29 additional amount that may be expended in each case, and his approval

1 shall be attached to the voucher.

2 \* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval  
3 or on the day it becomes law without approval.
