6 For an Act entitled: "An Act amending certain wholesale and beverage
7 license fees; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 04.10.110 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 04.10.110. WHOLESALE LICENSE. (a) The holder of a general
11 wholesale license may sell intoxicating liquors in the original package,
12 and wine in bulk[,] in quantities of not less than five wine gallons,
13 to holders of licenses. The holder of a general wholesale license
14 may not sell to a consumer. Liquor requiring internal revenue strip
15 stamps shall have the stamps intact on the package. A general whole-
16 sale license shall be required for each distributing point. The
17 general wholesale license fee [SCHEDULE] is based upon the total
18 amount of business transacted during any year. The [AND IS \$500 AS A]
19 minimum license fee is \$500, shall [TO] accompany the application, and
20 is [IN] payment of the license fee for the first \$50,000 of business
21 transacted. [,AND IN ADDITION THERETO, ON] On the business trans-
22 acted during any year an additional fee is payable in an amount
23 equal to one per cent of the gross receipts of the licensee in excess
24 of \$50,000.

8 (b) The holder of a wholesale malt beverage and wine license
 9 may sell malt beverages and wine in the original packages and malt
 10 beverages, and wine in bulk in quantities of not less than five wine
 11 gallons, to holders of licenses. The holder of a wholesale malt
 12 beverage and wine license may not sell to a consumer. The malt
 13 beverages and wine license fee [SCHEDULE] is based on the total amount
 14 of business transacted in any year. The [,AND IS \$100 AS A] minimum
 15 license fee is \$100, shall [TO] accompany the application, and is [IN]
 16 payment of the license fee for the first \$10,000 of business trans-
 17 acted. [,AND,IN ADDITION, ON] On the business transacted during any
 18 year[,] an additional fee is payable in an amount equal to one per
 19 cent of the gross receipts of the licensee in excess of \$10,000.
